GEORGE B. DERTILIS, member of the Academia Europaea and Professor Emeritus of Modern History of the University of Athens, is actually *directeur d'études* at the *Ecole des Hautes Etudes en Sciences Sociales*, in Paris. Between 1978 and 1999, he taught history at the University of Athens and, as visiting professor, at Harvard, Oxford, and the European University Institute (Florence). He was also member of numerous scientific or administrative boards, in Greece and in France: Fondation Les Treilles (Schlumberger), Maison Suger (Paris), Greek National Reference Committee for Scientific Research, National Research Centre, and the National Archives of Greece. He directed research programmes of the Cultural Foundation of the National Bank and the Archives of the University of Athens. He has widely published in modern and contemporary history of Greece and Europe, as well as in the theory and methodology of the Social Sciences. Distinctions: chevalier, Légion d'Honneur.
