ELIAMEP Researchers Dr Dia Anagnostou and Ms Anna Kandyla participate in the [ASSESS research project](#) (Assessing integration measures for vulnerable migrant groups) which will monitor and assess the effectiveness of integration measures that have been adopted at the level of Member States. The assessment, in particular, aims to identify the strengths and weaknesses in the application of the common EU guidelines and principles in the area of integration. It specifically focuses on the most vulnerable migrant groups, such as women, children and victims of trafficking.

Additionally, ELIAMEP, in collaboration with Taylor & Francis Group (Routledge Journals, London), are continuously committed to the dissemination of academic research on South East Europe and the Black Sea.
