

1. Palestinian killed while attacking an Israeli soldier (12.1.16)

A Palestinian was killed in the region of Hebron, in the north side of the West Bank, by the Israeli forces in his attempt to kill an Israeli soldier.

2. Sweden calls for an inquiry for possible Israeli extrajudicial executions against Palestinians (12.1.16)

Sweden's Minister of Foreign Affairs, Margot Wallström, called for an inquiry to be carried out in order to determine if Israel is responsible for "extrajudicial killings" of Palestinians during the current waver of terrorism. Wallström has criticized Israel repeatedly over Tel Aviv's human rights records; she also boosted Sweden's recognition of a Palestinian state shortly after becoming a foreign minister in 2014.

3. Israel responds to Sweden's accusations (14.1.16)

Benjamin Netanyahu called Wallström's critique outrageous, immoral, wrong and stupid. As he stated, self-defense against assailants is not to be seen as an extrajudicial killing. Otherwise, recent stabbing attacks against terrorists both in Paris and the US should also be seen as such. Deputy Foreign Minister Tipi Hotovely said that there has been a "degree of disconnect" between the two countries. Netanyahu also accused the EU of its policy against Israel.

4. A Palestinian killed and three injured during an Israeli air strike Gaza. (13.1.16)

A Palestinian was killed and three were injured during an Israeli air strike in Gaza during an Israeli raid on the pretext of attacking Hamas, which was preparing an attack against the Israeli forces in the Gaza Strip. After the attack the IDF called Israeli civilians to keep out of the borderline, due to possible Palestinian retaliation.
