

1. Hezbollah targets Israeli forces (02.01.16)

Hezbollah targeted Israeli forces at the borders between Lebanon and Israel, which provoked a response by Israel. Israeli forces confirmed that an explosive device set off near “military vehicles”. According to Hezbollah’s statements, the device detonated in the Shebaa field causing casualties. Lebanese media said the attack was used to retaliate for the murder of Samir Qatar, a commander killed in December.

2. Charges against two Jewish extremists (03.01.16)

Two Jewish extremists were accused of killing a Palestinian family, when they attacked by firebombing at their house, on the 31st July. One of the victims was an 18-month-old boy. Charges were pressed against the one of them, albeit not publicly. Israel’s Minister of Defense assured that the “Jewish terrorists” responsible for the firebombing are going to be accused.

3. IDF bombs Gaza (02.01.16)

Israeli Air Forces carried out bombings against Hamas in Gaza. Objectives were four of the installations in Beit Hanun, region in Gaza strip, in order to cause material damage and not deaths to victims. Israeli forces stated that Hamas is responsible, since all attacks derive from the Gaza Strip. Military sources said that rockets were launched from the West Bank causing only material damage to South Israel. Sunni islamists, who are members of the IS, took responsibility for the rockets launched. Despite that Israel continues to attribute Hamas the responsibility.

4. Israeli Arab shot pedestrians in Tel Aviv (02.01.16)

Two people were killed in Tel Aviv, while the fugitive responsible was recognized as a member of the Arab minority of the country. Security cameras captured the man, 25-30 years old, in a shop reaching for his gun from a bag and heading to the street while shooting. Three people were injured. The owner of the nearby shop stated on Israeli television that it was “definitely a terrorist attack”.
