

1. PA anger as the Aegean Airlines discriminated against Palestinian passengers (6.1.16)

The Aegean Airlines forced two Arabs to disembark from the plane because of complaints from Jewish passengers who accused them of being a threat to their security. Palestinian authorities demanded an investigation into the matter after the Palestinian and the Arab-Israeli passengers were forced by the Greek company to disembark before the flight took off from Greece.

2. Israeli soldiers shot down two Palestinians (9.1.16)

Israeli soldiers were on duty in the West Bank when they shot down two Palestinians who were about to start a stabbing attack against them. From October 1st, 22 Israelis and 146 Palestinians have been killed.

3. Israeli forces killed the Israeli Arab who shot people on New Year's Eve (9.1.16)

After a gunfire exchange the man who was responsible for the death of people by shooting was killed by the Israeli forces. The motives of the man still remain unknown. The man resisted with gunfire against the Israeli security forces. There were no victims from the gunfire. Israeli PM Netanyahu said the man was not a terrorist but a fugitive murderer.

4. Israeli army raids a Palestinian University to get “propaganda material.” (11.1.16)

The IDF raided a pro-Hamas Palestinian University in Ramallah overnight, seizing equipment suspected to be used for terrorist purposes. The University posted pictures of the scene after the attack. The local Islamist student party affiliated with Hamas won the student elections in the university's council last April.

5. Two Palestinians killed in the West Bank (12.1.16)

Israeli soldiers killed two Palestinians amid rising tension in the West Bank. Palestine's Ministry of Health said a 21-year-old boy was killed in the clash near Bethlehem. In another incident a 17-year-old youth was killed by Israeli soldiers in the same city. The Israeli army did not confirm the number of victims in Hebron.
