Dr. Dia Anagnostou (Ph.D. Cornell University, Department of Government, 1999) is Assistant Professor of Comparative Politics, in the Department of Public Administration at Panteion University of Social Sciences, and Senior Research Fellow at ELIAMEP from 2004 until present. She has held research positions at Princeton University (1999-2000), the Robert Schuman Centre at the European University Institute in Florence (2000-2001), and in the European University Institute 2009 as Fernand Braudel Fellow; and as Marie Curie Research Fellow in 2010-2012. Anagnostou is an expert with extensive research experience (over fifteen years) on issues of human rights and European governance. Her research has focused on the influence that courts, international law and supranational institutions exert in advancing rights, specifically in relation to gender equality, minorities, migrants and vulnerable groups. Anagnostou has coordinated and has been part of large research projects funded by the European Commission 6th and 7th Framework Program, as well as in Horizon 2020. Her articles have appeared in several book chapters and journals while she is currently working on a book manuscript on litigation and legal mobilization in the European Court of Human Rights.

These online series will gather various representatives from public institutions in local and central level, universities and academic institutions, national and local CSOs and media to discuss on costs and benefits of the process of European Integration and will increase the interest and information of about this process. The project aims to enhance Albanian public awareness of the EU integration as a generator of socio-economic reforms in order to promote the country's Europeanization, understanding challenges of costs-benefits, by providing specific pre and post-accession shared experiences from Greece, Bulgaria and Rumania.

A series of online activities (12 in total) are being organized throughout **July 2020** (every **Tuesday, Thursday and Friday**), while an added value is the contribution of experts and academics from Greece and Bulgaria.
