The US Elections' Day After: What Next for the Eastern Mediterranean?

The US elections of November 3rd could lead to a shift of US foreign policy in a number of regions, including the Eastern Mediterranean. The Eastern Mediterranean has emerged as a terrain of growing volatility, with Libya and Syria being plunged into catastrophic civil wars, the discovery of natural gas reserves reigniting old disputes, and Turkey raising its ambitions and becoming embroiled in a wide range of regional conflicts. What could be expected as the new US foreign policy blueprint in the Eastern Mediterranean? Would what some have described as a “US strategic withdrawal” from the region be reversed?
