The **Hellenic Foundation for European and Foreign Policy (ELIAMEP)**, within the framework of the [DEMOS](#) project, is organizing an **online public discussion** on:

“Taking stock of populism in Europe: ELIAMEP’s research on populism under the DEMOS project”

ELIAMEP is a partner institution of a pan-European consortium doing research on populism in Europe today and on how to manage the rise of populism through upgrading democratic efficacy. Since early 2019 the consortium, named DEMOS, has explored the following themes: different varieties of European populism, public policies of populists while in government, reactions of vulnerable groups targeted by populist actors and responses of mainstream or non-populist parties towards populist challengers. Based on available international theoretical and empirical research, ELIAMEP researchers, Dimitris Katsikas, Dimitri A. Sotiropoulos and Manos Tsatsanis, have conducted literature reviews, public policy analysis, interviews and focus group research on the themes outlined above, and will present parts of their work in a webinar on populism.
