Ahead of Italy's Elections: What is at stake?

Italy's national elections on 24 September 2022 are significant for Italy and the EU. Their result will determine the course of Italian economic and foreign policy after months of political stability guaranteed by the incumbent Prime Minister Mario Draghi. This webinar aims at analysing the importance of the elections by focusing on three main frames. The first is the political spectrum of dynamics in the Italian domestic scene, in particular the potential creation of a right-wing coalition government. The second is the expected relationship between Italy and the EU in the context of the continuing Ukraine crisis - and also in relation to the implementation of the Italian recovery plan. And the third is the future evolution of Italian foreign policy with an emphasis on the Mediterranean and Greek-Italian relations.
